The organisation

DangerPoint is a registered charity and company limited by guarantee, with a safety centre based in Talacre, North West Flintshire. As well as the small team of core staff and sessional staff, North Wales Fire & Rescue Service funds an administrative post and they also have a volunteer from Flintshire Work Options. The aim of DangerPoint is to educate children and young people in safety awareness in order to reduce the incidents of accidental deaths and injury; and to promote health, wellbeing and community safety.

The DangerPoint core programme is a 3 hour guided interactive tour for primary school pupils in years 5 and 6, designed to teach the children about making positive life choices, increase awareness of health and safety hazards, and reduce incidents of accidental injury.

Result of the project

- The report showed **64% of pupils now feel better that whole family is safe**
- The report findings shows **64% of the pupils have increased confidence to know what to do when in danger**
- **64% of both parents and pupils now feel safer in general**
- **DangerPoint work contributes to A Wales of Cohesive Communities of The well-being of future generations (Wales) act 2015**
