Tyddyn Mon provides a variety of activities and training during the day which are centred on a 35 acre farm. Tyddyn Mon is also one of the main providers of supported housing for adults with learning disabilities in Anglesey which enables them to live full and independent lives.

Results from the report

- 90% of service users indicated an improvement in their mental health
- 90% said that they felt more independent
- 86% that they felt less lonely
- 85% said that their physical health had improved
- The result positivity contributes to the 'A more equal Wales' & 'A healthier Wales' elements of the Future generations Wales (2015) act.
