

FAQs Gwynedd Youth Volunteering Grant

ENGLISH

What is the grant?

This grant is specifically targeting youth-led volunteering activities across Wales. We define youth volunteering as volunteering between the ages of 14-25. Project ideas should be designed and delivered by young people.

What can the grant be used for?

The grant will prioritise projects that meet the goals of the [Welsh Government's Future Generations and Wellbeing Act](#). Projects should also have a positive impact on the wider community.

Who is eligible for the grant?

To apply, a project should be part of a wider group or organisation, which has access to a bank account. If this is not in place, you might wish to consider forming a partnership with a group or organisation with access to a bank account where the grant can be paid into.

Our application has been successful, what happens next?

*Each grant panel across Wales will have their own specific requirements such as providing proof of expenditure and reporting. In general, panels will want to know how the money has been spent, what has gone well and what applicants would do differently if they could. All grants need to be spent by March 31st of the current financial year. Successful applicants **must** provide information about their projects through monitoring and case-studies.*
